Simply roll the unit in place and scrape leftover food, through the cutout in the solid top, into the scrap container below.

### And Stack.

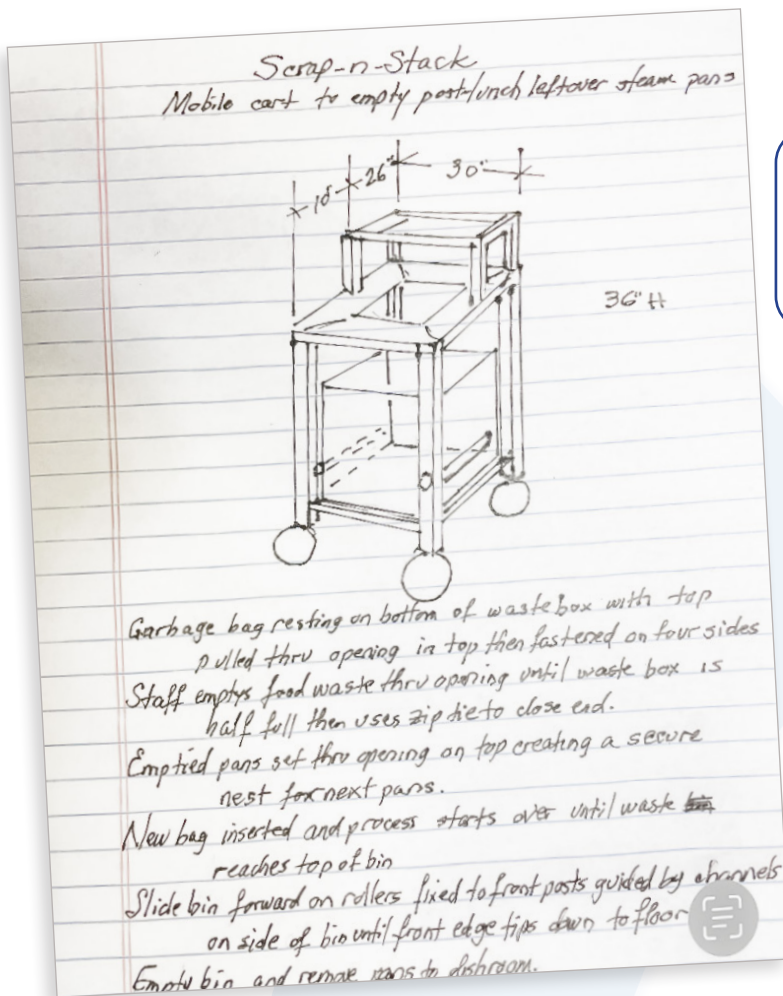
Steam table pans are stacked, two wide, and contained within the top rail. Sheet pans are stacked just below the top deck along with a removable soiled utensil container.

## Write It Down

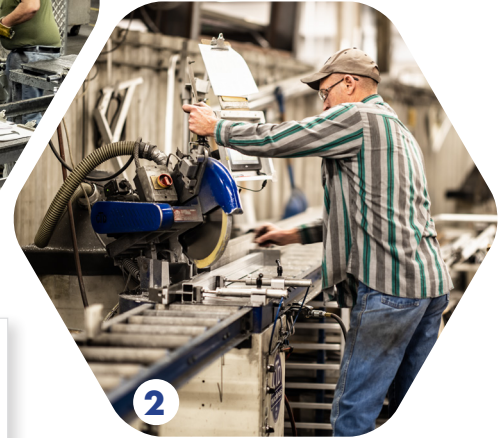
Details such as how the product is being used along with pan sizes help complete the vision.



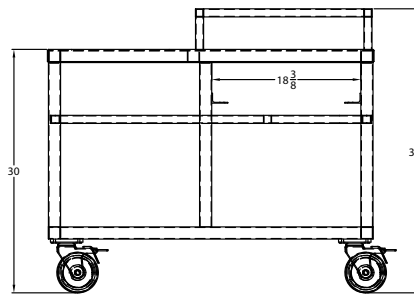
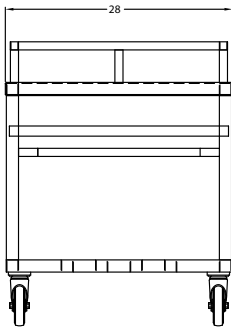
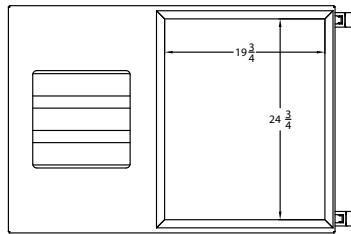

## [Final Drawing]



1. Tubing and angles are extruded from Primary Grade Alluminum using our extrusion press.
2. Extrusions are cut to length.
3. Parts are drilled, punched, bent and deburred before they head off to be welded.
4. Pieces are checked and measured carefully before being welded together.
5. Products are showered before final assembly and boxed for shipment.

The Scrap and Stack is a two-tier, open design cart with a waste chute for scraping and disposal, removable waste receptacle and soiled utensil repository. Built-in storage for empty steamtable and sheet pans makes this the go-to cart for quick and easy serving line cleanup.

Optional Handle - Factory Installed



Top mounted pan rail holds two rows of stacked 12"x 20" steamtable pans.

Angle slides mounted below holds stacked 18"x 26" sheet pans.
